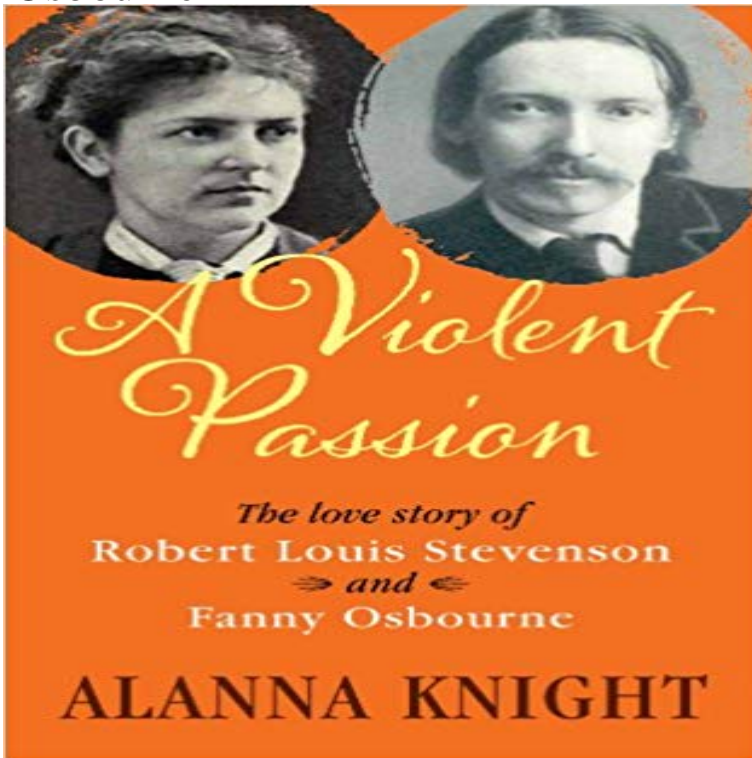


A Violent Passion. The Love Story of Robert Louis Stevenson & Fanny Osbourne
