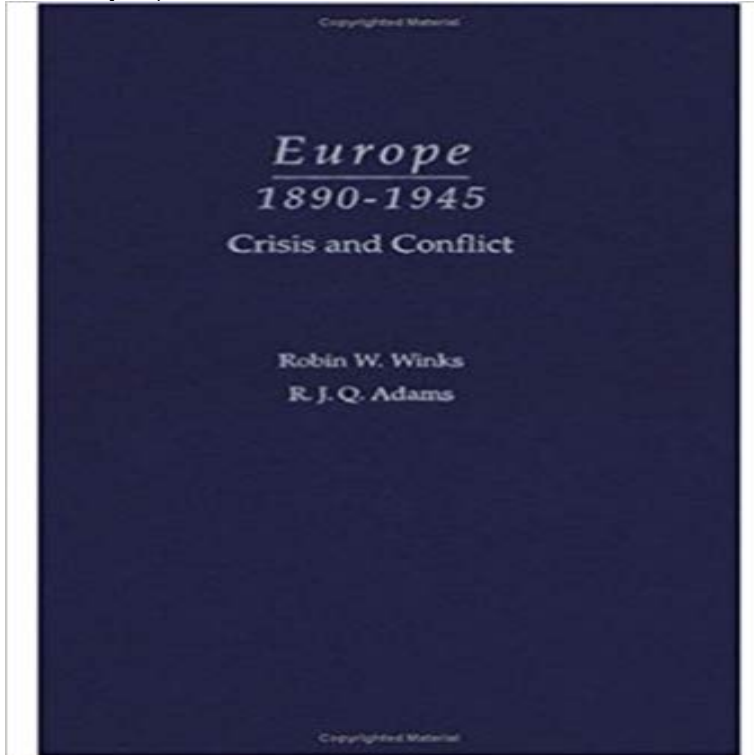


Europe, 1890-1945: Crisis and Conflict
