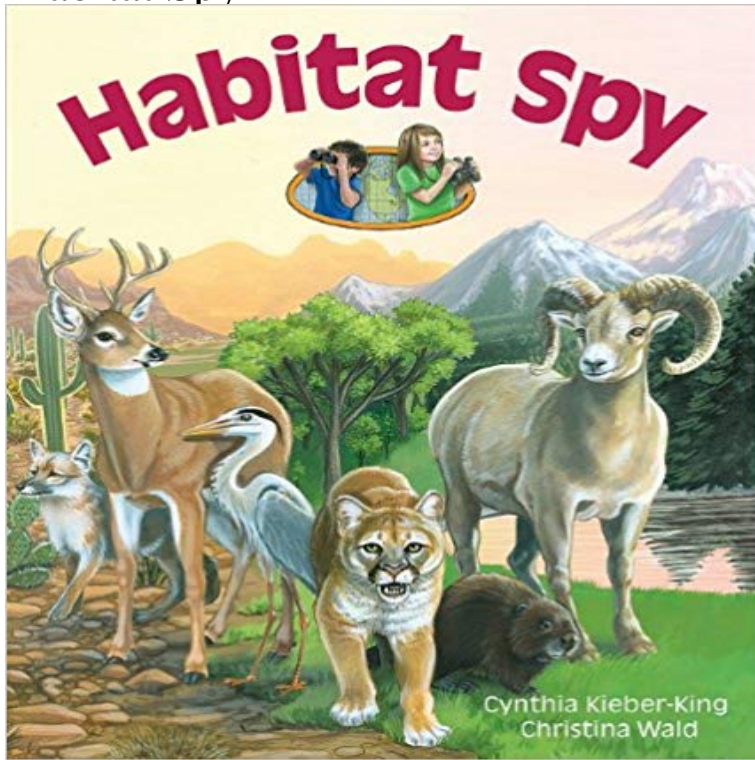


Habitat Spy
