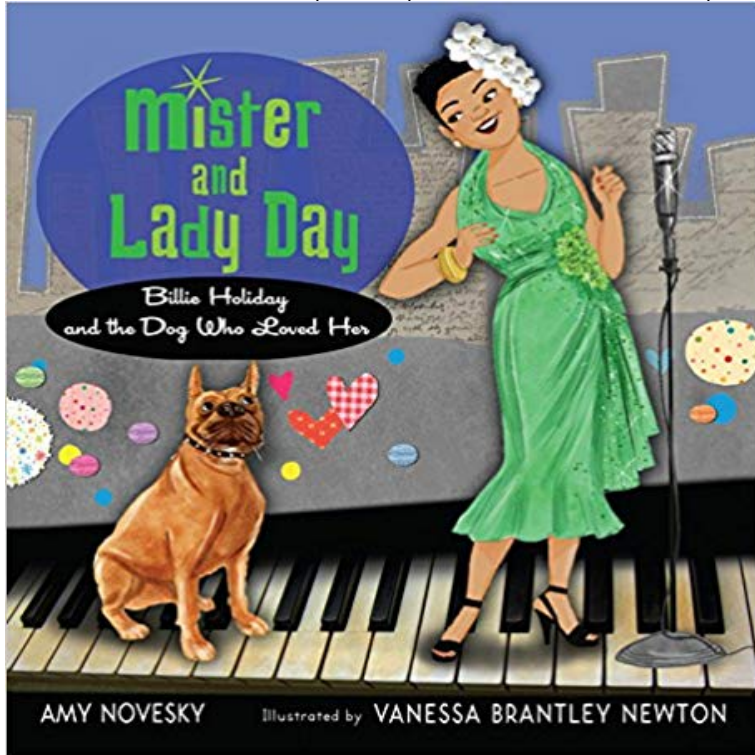


Mister and Lady Day: Billie Holiday and the Dog Who Loved Her
