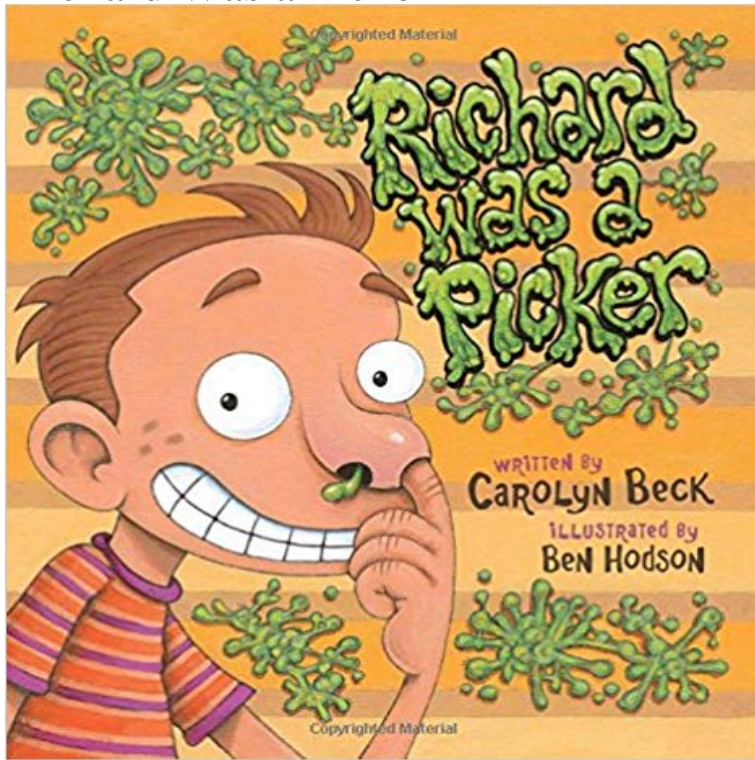


Richard Was a Picker
